The Year One to Year Two overall retention rate for the 2023 TUGH cohort (75%) is almost 10% higher than prior year, more than 7% higher than the five-year average, and the highest overall retention rate since at least 2008. Groups with the strongest retention rates in 2023 include White, Transfer, Foursquare, and Non-Athletes. Groups of concern include First-Time/Full-Time, Students of Color, Accepted on Academic Probation, and Athletes. Athlete versus Non-Athlete retention reversed significantly in the last year.


The Fall 2020 cohort has been removed from the five-year averages as an outlier due to the 100% attrition of the Soccer team that year. Note that the Soccer teams were disproportionately transfer, non-white (mostly Hispanic), non-Foursquare (mostly Catholic), first-generation, in-state, living in the residence halls, and enrolled in HDP and Business Administration.

With this caveat, the five-year average for all incoming TUGH students is 67.7%, a two percent increase over prior year. Reviewing the five-year averages and trends, the groups with the strongest retention rates are White, Transfer, Foursquare, and Non-First-Generation. The greatest at-risk groups (greater than 5% below average) are Students accepted on Academic Probation and Students of Color; First-Generation student retention rose slightly above the atrisk marker.

The strongest rates by initial major upon entrance are in the School of Theology & Ministry, especially the WAM and Ministry programs. The lowest are in the Media & Communication program (although it saw significant improvement this year) and the Business Administration program which was the only program below the overall average this year.

The retention rate for all 2023 incoming undergraduates was 75.5% and the five-year average is 68%. Transfer students retain at about an 8% higher rate than first-time freshman. Retention at LPU-VA typically exceeds the San Dimas campus, although the 2023 cohort did not; and has a five-year average of 74.4%, 6% higher than TUGH.

Retention rates in the OUG program improved significantly for all demographic groups and a 78.8% rate for all incoming OUG students. The 4-year average of 68% is similar to TUGH. Groups with the strongest retention rates in 2023 include Female and Non-Pell Eligible. ITP and Male students are groups of concern. Looking at 4-year averages, ITP, Students of Color, and Non-Foursquare are the greatest concern, followed by Male and Pell-eligible (note that all of these groups except ITP were pulled down by the poor 2022 cohort numbers).

The 6-year (150%) graduate rate for the 2018 TUGH cohort (40.7%) is significantly lower than the prior three years which were all over 50%. The primary reason for the decrease was the very low rate for male athletes (especially in the wrestling program which had poor retention and was closed in 2022) who made up a large amount of the incoming student enrollment that year. This brought down the overall graduation rate as well as the rate for many demographic groups including Male, Students of Color, and Non-Foursquare. Groups with the strongest rates include White, Female, Foursquare, and Non-Athletes; all remaining about 50%.

This also brought the five-year average below 50% (48.1%). Reviewing the five-year averages and trends, the groups with the strongest retention rates are White, Female, Transfer, Foursquare, Pell Recipients, and Residence Hall. The greatest at-risk groups (greater than 5% below average) are Students accepted on Academic Probation, Male, Commuter, and Athletes. and Students of Color.

The 6-year graduation rates by initial major upon entrance are within a few percent of the average for all programs except for lower rate for WAM, although WAM and Media & Communication do not yet have 5 full years of data.

The 4-year (100%) graduation rates reflect similar issues since they include the 2018 cohort and are accentuated even more by the 2020 cohort which included the loss of the entire incoming Soccer teams. This had an extremely detrimental effect on the 2020 cohort rate (22.8%) which was 16% lower overall than prior year and negatively affected almost all demographic groups except for Non-athletes, Foursquare, and Commuter.
